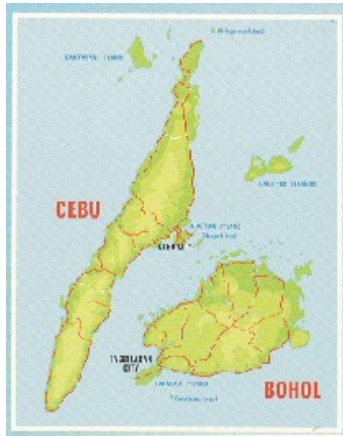

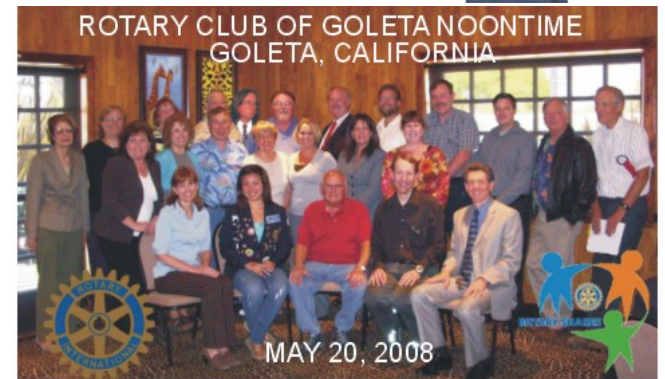
4.) David Gore's Rotary Minute was on Rotary's attempt to set a world record with book collection to happen at the Rotary International Convention to be held in June.
