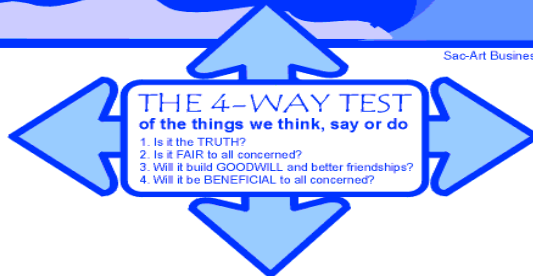


# THE SCHOONER

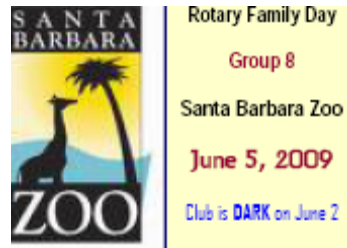


**So what do these two pictures have in common?**
