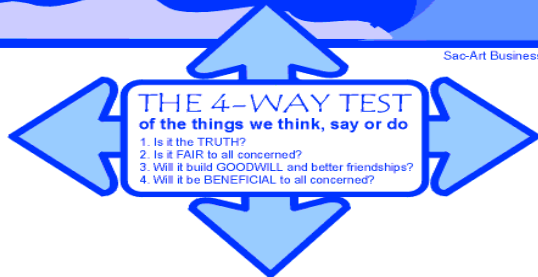


THE SCHOONER
